The Lacey City Council presented the 2022 State Legislative Priorities to the Washington State Legislators from District 2 and 22:

1. Continue to focus on I-5 Corridor between Mounts Road to Tumwater and the Nisqually River Delta
2. Affordable-Housing Solutions that Work for All
3. Public Safety Concerns: Return of Less-lethal Options, Use of Force, and Commission Clarifications
4. Request State Leadership in Providing Strategies and Tools to address the Growing Unsheltered Population in Washington Cities
5. Capital Budget Requests:

- a. Public Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Expansion
- b. Oxford Model House Program with Non-Profit Partner
